2010 JR. DRAGSTER SERIES POINTS PROGRAM

The IHRA Junior Dragster Program is designed to allow youth, as young as 8 and up to 18 the opportunity to race against their peers in near replica models of the models that the pro's drive. They compete at a local track level, divisional level, as well as at the Summit Team Bracket Finals, and the new Junior Team Finals Events. These events are contested on an 1/8 mile format on an ET dial your own format or a pre-set index on a heads up breakout basis. With three levels of Junior Dragster competition, it makes this class a great starting point for competitors to learn the basic of drag racing while promoting family fun.

We want to re-establish our Jr. Dragster Program, and are going to actively pursue bringing them back to Bluegrass Raceway. Let us assure you that we will go all out to help our Jr. Dragsters build a program which lets them race this year and will work with you to bring their cars into competition shape.

This year when you sign up you also become a member of the Bluegrass Raceway Horsepower Club. You will receive a member id card and window sticker to display your affiliation. This is the same club that the SP/No-Box Points racers are members of, putting you in league with and placing equal importance on the Jr Dragster as a Racer and Points Series participant.

RULES

- * Junior has to stage on it own power, no touching / helping driver after Junior has pre-stage...1 time - warning, 2nd time DQ.
- * Only 2 crew member / Parent past burn out area.
- * If junior stalls past burn out , you will have 1 attempt at re-starting then after thats its up to officals.
- * Parents are roll models to the juniors, Please lets have fun !!
- * All IHRA rules apply.
- * No dial ins faster than 7.90.
- * Its the Driver / crew cheif responsibility to check dial ins, if driver pre-stages you accept it.
- * Must have working tail light, no tail light, 1 warning , 2nd DQ.
- * No driving Juniors back to pit area, must be towed by a licenced driver.
- * All rounds will be paired with a ladder or cards.
- * No Double entries allowed.
- * Must wear all saftey equipment.
- * No junior driver to be operating and kind of pit vehicle, get caught and be DQ from event....that is under 16 and dont have a drivers licences.
- * Any kind of malfunction is final by the track manager, and only racers involved and parents to be dealt with.
- * No holding Juniors in burnout or burning through staging beams.
- * Deep staging is permitted.
- * Any question come and see track manager.

CLASS DESIGNATIONS

BEGINNER: Age 8 or 9 only; ET restricted to 12.90 seconds or slower based on either ET dial-your-own or heads-up basis. Breakout rules apply. One warning will be issued if a competitor runs quicker than 12.70. If the competitor does this a second time at the same event, they will be disqualified from the event. Any competitor running quicker than 12.50 at any time will be disqualified for the remainder of the event.

ADVANCED: Age 10 to 17; modified engines meeting IHRA rules accepted. Class based on either dial-your-own ET or heads-up Pro start. ET restricted to 8.90 or slower. Breakout rules apply. One warning will be issued if a competitor runs quicker than 8.70. If a competitor runs quicker than 8.70 a second time, at the same event, they will be disqualified from the event. Any competitor running quicker than 8.50 any time will be disqualified for the remainder of the event.

MASTER: Age 12 to 17; must meet all requirements for Advanced, PLUS: minimum 1 full licensed competition season mandatory; the competitor must provide documentation of experience and submit it with all license applications, licensing by IHRA or Track official after 3 approved runs between 7.90 and 8.90; Rack & pinion steering, and steel brake lines are mandatory.

ET 7.90 or slower; maximum speed of 85 mph: One warning will be issued if a competitor runs an elapsed time of 7.80 or quicker or 85 mph. If a competitor does this a second time at the same event they will be disqualified from the event. If a competitor runs 7.70 or quicker they will be disqualified for the remainder of the event and their license will be suspended for 6 months from the date of the infraction.

Due to the radical combinations available for the class additional safety requirements may be mandated if deemed necessary by the technical department.

*Deep staging not permitted in any index class at any IHRA event. 12.90 index is limited to only 8 and 9 year old competitors.
